3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Department of Vet-5 erans Affairs Veterans Education Relief and Restoration

6 Act of 2015".

1	SEC. 2. RESTORATION OF ENTITLEMENT TO EDUCATIONAL
2	ASSISTANCE AND OTHER RELIEF FOR VET-
3	ERANS AFFECTED BY CLOSURES OF EDU-
4	CATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.
5	(a) EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE.—
6	(1) IN GENERAL.—Section 3312 of title 38,
7	United States Code, is amended by adding at the
8	end the following new subsection:
9	"(d) DISCONTINUATION OF EDUCATION DUE TO
10	CLOSURE OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION.—
11	"(1) IN GENERAL.—Any payment of edu-
12	cational assistance described in paragraph (2) shall
13	not—
14	"(A) be charged against any entitlement to
15	educational assistance of the individual con-
16	cerned under this chapter; or
17	"(B) be counted against the aggregate pe-
18	riod for which section 3695 of this title limits
19	the individual's receipt of educational assistance
20	under this chapter.
21	"(2) Description of payment of edu-
22	CATIONAL ASSISTANCE.—Subject to paragraph (3),
23	the payment of educational assistance described in
24	this paragraph is the payment of such assistance to
25	an individual for pursuit of a course or courses

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1	under this chapter if the Secretary finds that the in-
2	dividual—
3	"(A) was forced to discontinue such course
4	pursuit as a result of a permanent closure of an
5	educational institution; and
6	"(B) did not receive credit, or lost training
7	time, toward completion of the program of edu-
8	cation being pursued at the time of such clo-
9	sure.
10	"(3) Period for which payment not
11	CHARGED.—The period for which, by reason of this
12	subsection, educational assistance is not charged
13	against entitlement or counted toward the applicable
14	aggregate period under section 3695 of this title
15	shall not exceed the aggregate of—
16	"(A) the portion of the period of enroll-
17	ment in the course or courses from which the
18	individual failed to receive credit or with respect
19	to which the individual lost training time, as de-
20	termined under paragraph $(2)(B)$, and
21	"(B) the period by which monthly stipend
22	is extended under section $3680(a)(2)(B)$ of this
23	title.".
24	(2) Applicability.—Subsection (d) of such
25	section, as added by paragraph (1), shall apply with

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1	respect to courses and programs of education discon-
2	tinued as described in subparagraph (A) or (B) of
3	paragraph (2) of such subsection in fiscal year 2015
4	or any fiscal year thereafter.
5	(b) Monthly Housing Stipend.—
6	(1) IN GENERAL.—Section 3680(a) of such title
7	is amended—
8	(A) by striking the matter after paragraph
9	(3)(B);
10	(B) in paragraph (3), by redesignating
11	subparagraphs (A) and (B) as clauses (i) and
12	(ii), respectively;
13	(C) by redesignating paragraphs (1)
14	through (3) as subparagraphs (A) through (C),
15	respectively;
16	(D) in the matter before subparagraph
17	(A), as redesignated, in the first sentence, by
18	striking "Payment of" and inserting "(1) Ex-
19	cept as provided in paragraph (2), payment of";
20	(E) by adding at the end the following new
21	paragraph (2):
22	((2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), the Secretary
23	may, pursuant to such regulations as the Secretary shall
24	prescribe, continue to pay allowances to eligible veterans

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and eligible persons enrolled in courses set forth in para graph (1)(A)—

3 "(A) during periods when schools are tempo4 rarily closed under an established policy based on an
5 Executive Order of the President or due to an emer6 gency situation, except that the total number of
7 weeks for which allowances may continue to be so
8 payable in any 12-month period may not exceed four
9 weeks; or

"(B) solely for the purpose of awarding a
monthly housing stipend described in section 3313
of this title, during periods following a permanent
school closure, except that payment of such a stipend may only be continued until the earlier of—

15 "(i) the date of the end of the term, quar16 ter, or semester during which the school closure
17 occurred; and

18 "(ii) the date that is 4 months after the19 date of the school closure.".

20 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Paragraph
21 (1)(C)(ii) of such section, as redesignated, is amend22 ed by striking "described in subclause (A) of this
23 clause" and inserting "described in clause (ii)".
